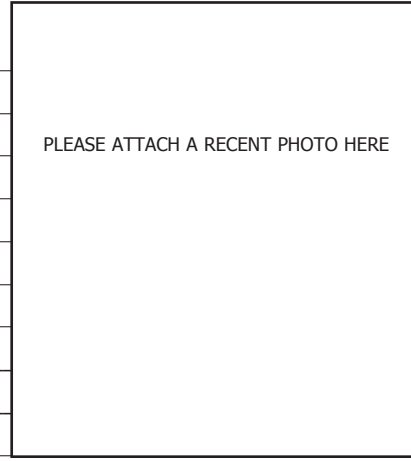

We recognize that an independent school education is a major investment, one which often stretches a family's resources. Chatham Hall offers need-based financial aid to families who demonstrate need under the guidelines of the School and Student Service for Financial Aid (SSS). Our financial aid program is designed to bridge the gap between the Comprehensive Fee and what a family can reasonably contribute toward their daughter's education.

DIRECTIONS FROM REGIONAL AIRPORTS

LYNCHBURG REGIONAL AIRPORT, VA

(45 MINUTES FROM CHATHAM HALL)

Take US 29 South to the second Chatham exit (Route 685). Turn right at the top of the exit ramp. Turn left onto Peach Street, and then left onto the Chatham Hall campus. The Admission Office is located in Pruden Hall.

GREENSBORO (PIEDMONT TRIAD) AIRPORT, NC

(1 HOUR AND 30 MINUTES FROM CHATHAM HALL)

Follow the signs to Interstate Highway 40 East. Take I-40 East. In Greensboro, take US 29 North to Danville. In Danville, follow the signs for the US 29 Bypass. Continue on US 29 North for about 18 miles and take the first Chatham exit. On Main Street, after the traffic light for Route 57, take the second right onto Pruden Street. At the bottom of the hill, proceed straight to the Chatham Hall campus. The Admission Office is located in Pruden Hall.

RALEIGH-DURHAM INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, NC

(2 HOURS FROM CHATHAM HALL)

From the airport, take I-40 West to the Hillsborough exit, Route 86 North. Follow the signs to 86 North and stay on to south of Danville. South of Danville, take the exit for the US 29 Bypass, north to Lynchburg. Continue on US 29 North for about 18 miles and take the first Chatham exit. On Main Street, after the traffic light for Route 57, take the second right onto Pruden Street. At the bottom of the hill, proceed straight on to the Chatham Hall campus. The Admission Office is located in Pruden Hall.
