The Schedule. For five-day boarders, the week begins at Chapel on Sunday evening and ends on Friday afternoon. They are allowed to stay on campus one weekend each trimester and on specific Friday and Saturday nights when they have a commitment (sports, testing, etc.) the next day.

The Circle. Five-day boarders live within a two-hour drive of campus. That includes the Triad and Triangle in North Carolina, and Charlottesville, Roanoke, Blacksburg, and Lynchburg in Virginia.

The Difference. Chatham Hall is a small school — by design. It is important to us to be a community. However, the experiences we offer (on campus and around the world) are *big, very big*. It is a rare combination — personal attention and outstanding opportunities — that translates into a sterling education.

Chatham Hall girls go to the country's best colleges and universities. They include Stanford, Duke, Cornell, and Vassar. They are mentored by a *top-tier faculty*.
